The Lauwaki Women's Co-operative Limited started with 10 members, and has total net assets of \$51,196.75 as at 30 June 2019.

As a source of employment, the co-operative currently employs four members and has actively contributed towards a new library for a kindergarten within the community valued at \$3,000.

At present, to diversify business operations, the co-operative is planning to operate an Internet cafe to assist students with computer services and access to Internet for the purpose of conducting research.

Like other successful co-operatives, at the end of each financial year, members receive paid bonuses according to the volume of transactions within the co-operative.
